How to Share About Living Threads with Grieving Families

"I wish I had known about Living Threads before I got rid of all the clothing."

This is the most common comment I hear from people who have lost a loved one. There is a great way to share with your family and friends about having a memory quilt made before it is too late.

- As you go through visitation or talk to someone immediately following a death, please don't bombard them with all kinds of information. It's too early and too overwhelming.
- Instead, show you care in a non-threatening way. . . all you have to say is, "I have something I'd like to share with you when you're ready but, until we talk, please don't get rid of your (child, husbands, etc) clothing. We'll touch base later when you're ready." It's that easy!
- Later when things have settled down your grieving friend will call you to inquire. They will be so appreciative—they often haven't thought of this in the moment, but it will be a treasured possession in the future!





Kibera Bible Club Christmas

Every Saturday, hundreds of children show up at the nine Bible Clubs with anticipation of *being fed physically and spiritually*. Christmas was celebrated with 600 children, 85% of the children who regularly attend. They were led in a praise and worship session as well as a morning devotion. Our facilitators had prepared the "Jesus Story" in form of a video that elaborated the birth of Jesus Christ, our children were glued to the screen!

The cooks came early and they prepared healthy and delicious meals such as pan cake, rice, stew of meat, cabbage and fruits.

Children were served generously and they ate to their fullest. The climax of the day was the cutting of a gigantic cake. What a moment! On behalf of these innocent souls, we say "Thank you" for the light in the children's faces with memorable Christmas joy.
