The year 2020 marked the 10 year anniversary of Living Threads. God receives all the honor and glory for all the ways He has blessed us since we opened in 2020. Our anniversary events were scheduled, our calendar was filled, but then COVID and "Shelter in Place" hit. Throughout this year God has reminded us through Proverbs 19:21, "You can make many plans, but the Lord's purpose will prevail".

Below you will see that only by God's miraculous hand could 2020 have had the results we experienced. We were closed from March 24—June 15, leaving us basically *only 9 months* to be at the ministry center creating memory quilts. Join us in praising God for *all* that HE has done using *you* to accomplish HIS purposes.



\$23,784.20 was raised for the Kibera Slum in 2020

We're delighted we raised \$345.55 *more* than what was donated in 2019 bringing our total donations since 2010 up to \$178,010.66. Volunteers worked less hours, we made less quilts, yet our donations to support the children in the Kibera Bible Clubs *increased!* **God is so good!**



111 Memory Quilts Ordered in 2020—only 7 less than 2019!

Isn't it amazing, that in the middle of a pandemic the ministry was able to continue to do God's Kingdom work and bring comfort to families that are deeply grieving the loss of their loved ones. *God is so good!*



1874.33 Volunteer Sewing Hours in 2020

Due to Covid Shelter At Home *and* the fact that we can only have 8 volunteer sewers at time instead of 15 (due to 6' spacing requirements) volunteer hours are less than previous years. Even so, our wonderful volunteers were committed to come sew even though that meant wearing a mask all day. *God is so good!*

247 Longarm Quilts (Client & Community) in 2020

Once again we see God's provision for Living Threads—after being closed for 3 months our longarm quilters hands were busy. *God is so good!*



BBOM (Bible Block of the Month)—Sold Out!

God's provision shines out again! 55 students signed up for BBOM. Due to Covid restrictions we couldn't sign up as many as previous years, but all the seats were filled. *God is so good!*

Every month 90 children drawn from the 7 Bible Clubs supported by Living Threads gathered to hear a brief Bible Story lesson *and* receive a lesson to take home. After sharing a dish of porridge together the children receive *fully packed food baskets that will be enough for them to eat for a whole month!*

We are so thankful God has blessed us with partners like you so we can help provide food during this trying time as well as continue to share the Bible through Take Home Bible Club.

Women who have miscarried, delivered a still born, or experienced an abortion often grieve alone and privately. What if there was a tangible way that you could bring comfort to a family who has walked through the grief of a childbearing loss? Thanks to a group of courageous moms willing to share their stories, there is!

With the help of these moms, Living Threads created pillows representing the love and loss of a precious life. Pillows are made from quality cotton fabrics with a zippered back (making them easy to wash and keep clean). A premium polished cotton pillow form is included.

If you know of someone who has experienced this kind of child loss, please consider reaching out to them in the midst of their grief with the gift of a pillow. Just as our memory quilts bring comfort to families grieving their loved ones these pillows can bring comfort to a mom experiencing a childbearing loss.

There are 3 pillow back options that include a label expressing the heartfelt emotions of the parent(s).

Pillows are priced in a 2-tier format. A base price of \$39 covers all the supply and quilting costs. A donation for the volunteer hours is also required (approximately 5 hours). 100% of the proceeds will support the life of a child living in extreme poverty in the Kibera Slum, Nairobi, Kenya
