- Our volunteer quilters/sewers are excited about the future sewing projects at Living Threads and I'm
 pleased to report we have 100% retention!! As we currently do, ALL sewing will take place at the
 Living Threads ministry center which fulfills our mission statement to *"provide purposeful community"*for our volunteers.

- New memory quilt client orders have ceased. Volunteers are working on current memory quilt orders with the goal of all projects completing by the end of May.
- The Longarm Quilting department continues to be open to the public. However, May 1st will be the final day that new quilts will be received for longarming.
- Bible Block of the Month classes continue strong with the final class to be held on May 15th.
- Approximately June 1st, we will begin our new "Sewing/Quilting for Kenya". The current longarm room will become our new and larger "Martha" sewing room!!
