







3 New Bible Clubs Opening Soon!!



During the week of July 20-25, Living Threads and International Needs collaborated at Maranatha Bible and Missionary Conference in Muskegon to present the Kibera Slum Bible Clubs. Our hope was to raise funds to open two more Bible Clubs in unreached villages. However, God did "immeasurably more than we could have imagined" that week. Through the sacrificial giving of the members and guests, three more villages in the Kibera Slum will now have a Bible Club and 400-500 more children will be spiritually and physically fed! As quoted by our partners in Kenya, "this is great encouragement to us and will significantly advance the work God has entrusted to our hands."

What is so impressive is the intentionality, planning, and accountability that takes place for opening any new Club.

There are six criteria that are evaluated and the three new Bible Club locations have already met these criteria.

- 1. **Prayer and discernment**: seeking God's will for a new Bible Club.
- 2. The need: identifying under served villages or hotspots for at-risk children.
- 3. **Security:** Based on date collected on crime, areas are determined where staff and children can safely gather.
- 4. Local slum church and pastoral involvement
- 5. Community assessments are done to identify unmet needs.
- 6. Parental and the community support is a must and surveys are conducted to ensure their participation.

We thank and praise God for providing for these 3 new Bible Clubs which will be opening in August and September!!

If you'd like to travel to Kenya and visit the Bible Clubs, International Needs is offering two "Experience, Envision, Encourage" trips on January 21-29, 2026 and January 28-February 5, 2026. 


